
SubliMate™ Color Profiles (Windows)

How to load a color profile for Adobe Suite Applications

This bulletin describes the procedure on how to use custom profiles for SubliMate[™] Ink. The images below correspond to a profile created and loaded in Adobe Photoshop, but applies to other products of the suite.

Once your printer is installed and loaded with SubliMate TM ink, download your color profile and save it on your preferred location in your computer.

Right Click on the Color Profile and select **Install Profile**. Your file will be saved automatically in Windows so you can use it.



2. Select your printer and click on Print Settings to access your printer diver







3. In the Printer Driver in the **Main Tab**, choose your: Paper Source and Document Size.

The recommended settings for paper are: Paper Type: Plain Paper / Bright White Paper

Quality: High




4. In the More Options Tab, check the Custom Color Correction and select Advanced.

In the Advanced Color Correction window, select No Color Adjust.

You can also check the Mirror Image option since you need to print in reverse.

Once this options are selected Click OK





6. In the Application Print Settings look for the *Color Management* option, go to *Color Handling* and select Photoshop Manage Colors.



Then select the Printer *Profile Tab* scroll down and select the
Custom Color Profile you install
on Step 1 for your printer.

Be sure your *Rendering Intent* is set to Perceptual

7. Print image and transfer.
